## Cutting Instructions



- Blocks: 6" x 27" strip (for Triangles on a Roll) or Eighteen 3" squares of 'star' fabric
- Blocks: One 2½ "strip WOF\* of the star fabric, cross-cut into nine 2½" squares
- Blocks: 6" x 27" strip (for Triangles on a Roll) or Eighteen 3" squares of background fabric
- Blocks: Two and a half 2½" strips WOF of the background fabric, cross-cut into thirty-six 2½" squares
- Border: Four strips 4 1/2" x 18 1/2"
- Border: Four 4 1/2" squares for cornerstones
- Binding: Three 2 1/4" strips WOF
- Backing & Batting: 29" x 29"

## Sewing Instructions





- Make 36 half square triangles using your favorite method.
- ☐ Press towards the darker fabric.
- ☐ Trim the half square triangles to 2 1/2" square.
- Arrange plain squares alternating with the half square triangles to make a Friendship Star block.
- When making the rows, press the seams in the top and bottom row to the outside, and the seams in the center row to the inside.
- When sewing the three rows together, press the seams to the center of the block.
- ☐ The Friendship Star unit should measure 6 1/2" square.
- Make nine Friendship Star units.
- ☐ Arrange the Friendship Star units into three rows of three units each.
- □ Rotate every other block 1/4 turn, so that the direction of the seams will alternate.
- Sew three units into a row. Make three rows.
- ☐ Sew the three rows together.
- The top should now measure 18 1/2" x 18 1/2".

Step 4:




- Sew a border strip to each of two opposite sides only of the quilt center.
- Press seams towards borders.

Step 5:

- ☐ Sew a 4 1/2" cornerstone square to each end of the remaining two border strips.
- Press seams towards border strip.

Step 6:



- Sew these border strip units to the remaining two sides of the quilt.
- ☐ Press the seams towards the borders.

Step 7:

- □ Layer with batting and backing and quilt.
- ☐ Put on the binding and label.
