Cutting Instructions



Blocks:

- □ Four 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares (medium value) Colour Family A (light to medium value):
- ☐ One 2" strip WOF* of first fabric
- ☐ Two 2" strips WOF of second fabric
- ☐ Three 2" strips WOF of third fabric Colour Family B (medium to dark value, darker than A):
- □ One 2" x 20" strip of first fabric
- ☐ One 2" strips WOF of second fabric
- One 2" strips WOF of third fabric
- ☐ Two 2" strips WOF of fourth fabric
- Border: Three 3 1/2" strips WOF
- ☐ Binding: Three 2 1/4" strips WOF
- Batting and Backing: 30" x 30" square

Sewing Instructions


Step 1: First Round - Light

Step 2: First Round - Medium





- □ Cross-cut the 2" strip of the first fabric from Colour Family A into four 3 1/2" segments and four 5" segments.
- ☐ Join one 3 1/2" segment to one side of one 3 1/2" square.
- Press the seam towards the darker fabric.
- ☐ Join one 5" segment to the unit as shown.
- ☐ Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- Make 4.





Family B into four 5" segments.

 \square Join the 5" segment as shown (previously sewn strip is always at the top).

- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- \square Cross-cut the 2" strip of the second fabric from Colour Family B into four $6^{1/2}$ " segments.
- ☐ Join the 6 1/2" segment as shown.
- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- Make 4.

Step 3: Second Round - Light






- ☐ Cross-cut the two strips from the second fabric from Colour Family A into a total of four 6 1/2" segments and four 8" segments.
- □ Join one 6 1/2" segment as shown.
- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- ☐ Join one 8" segment to the unit as shown.
- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- □ Make 4.


^{*}WOF = Width of Fabric (fabric needs to measure 40" wide without salvages after pre-washing)


Step 4: Second Round - Medium



- Cross-cut the 2" strip of the second fabric from Colour Family B into four 8" segments.
- ☐ Join the 8" segment as shown (previously sewn strip is always at the top).
- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- Cross-cut the 2" strip of the fourth fabric from Colour Family B into four 9 1/2" segments.
- \Box Join the 9 1/2" segment as shown.
- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- Make 4.


Step 5: Third Round - Light





- Cross-cut the three strips from the third fabric from Colour Family A into a total of four $9^{1/2}$ " segments and four 11" segments.
- \Box Join one 9 1/2" segment as shown.
- Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- ☐ Join one 11" segment to the unit as shown.
- ☐ Press the seam away from the center of the unit.
- Make 4.

Step 6: Join the Blocks



□ Join the four log cabin blocks with the dark sides together.

Step 7: Add the Borders

- ☐ Cut two border strips 3 ½" x 21 ½". Join to opposite sides of the center unit. Press seams away from the center.
- ☐ Cut two border strips 3 1/2" x 27 1/2". Join to the remaining opposite sides of the center unit. Press seams away from the center.

Step 8: Finishing

- lacktriangle Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
- Quilt as desired.
- □ Put on the binding and label.
