## All blocks will be 12 1/2" unfinished..... 12" finished

**Note:** Instructions for 1 block. If you are making one for the block lotto and one for yourself, you will need to double the cutting instructions.



We are doing a split complimentary harmony in Red-orange, Blue-violet and Yellow-green this month. You choose the background again... Either white or black.



Let's do a Carrie Nation block!

If you remember, split complimentary is one color, and the two colors on each side of it's compliment. This month we will use red-orange, blue-violet and yellow-green. Background will be your choice of white or black. Use tone on tone prints, solids, batiks, if it reads like one of these colors.... Give it a chance. Remember to vary your values and textures.

## Sewing: Use a scant 1/4" seam allowance.

	Using the blue-violet and yellow-green 3½"	Make 2
~1 ×1	squares make 4 patch units. You will make 2. These will measure 6 ½"	
0.00	unfinished.	



Sew the orange-red and background strips (18 x 2) Together. Press toward the darker color. This strip should measure 3 ½".




2" 2"

Sub-cut into 2" segments. Each will measure 3 ½" x 2". Make 8 of them.



Match up the 8 segments into pairs. Stitch to create mini 4 patch units. Press. These units will now measure 3 1/2" square. Make 4









Match the mini 4 patches units with the 3 ½" background squares to create 2 larger 4 patch units. Carefully lay the units out like the picture on the left. The orange squares will travel diagonally. Stitch and press. These will measure 6 ½" square.



Carefully lay the units out like the picture on the left. The orange squares will travel in one direction diagonally. The blue-violet will travel on the other diagonal. Stitch and press.





Your block now measures 12 ½" square
