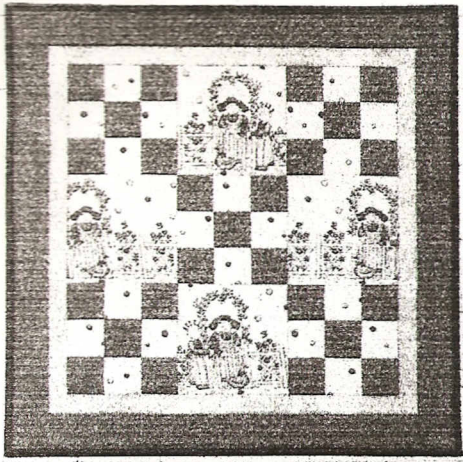


Cutting Instructions



Blocks:

- ❑ Four 6 1/2" squares of a theme print
- ❑ Four and a half 2 1/2" strips WOF (medium value)
- ❑ Two 2 1/2" strips WOF (light value)

Inner Border:

- ❑ Two 19 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips (accent colour)
- ❑ Two 21 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips (accent colour)
(If the fabric is wide enough, these can be cut from two 1 1/2" strips WOF.)

❑ Outer Border

Binding:

- ❑ Three 2 1/4" strips WOF (dark value)

Battling & Backing:

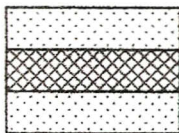
- ❑ 27" x 27" squares

Sewing Instructions

Step 1:

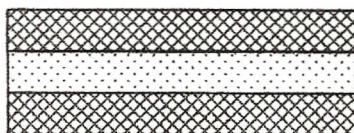
- ❑ From two of the medium strips, cut a 22" long segment from each strip. Reserve the 22" strips for the outer border.
- ❑ From two of the remaining medium strips, cut a 26" long segment from each strip. Reserve the 26" strips for the outer border.

Step 2:



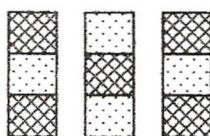
- ❑ Cut two 14" lengths from one light strip.
- ❑ Sew the two short light strips to one of the shorter medium strips left over from step 1 in light - medium - light order.
- ❑ Press seams towards to the darker fabric.
- ❑ Cross-cut into five 2 1/2" segments.

Step 3:



- ❑ Sew two medium strips and one light strip together into medium - light - medium sequence.
- ❑ Make two of these strip sets from the remaining medium and light strips.
- ❑ Press seams towards to the darker fabric.
- ❑ Cross-cut into ten 2 1/2" segments.

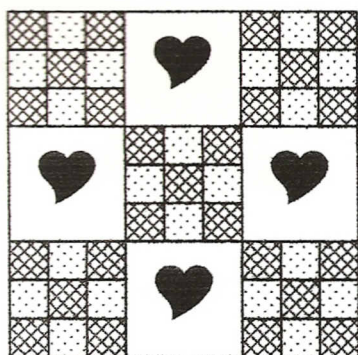
Step 4:



- ❑ Sew the 2 1/2" segments together to make five nine-patches.
- ❑ Press seams away from the center.
- ❑ The nine patches should measure 6 1/2" square.

*WOF = Width of Fabric (fabric needs to measure 40" wide without salvages after pre-washing)

Step 5:



- Sew the nine-patches and the feature fabrics together, alternating the blocks, into three rows.
- Sew the rows together.
- This unit should measure 18 1/2" square.

Step 6:

- Sew on the two 19 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips for the inner border, one to each of two opposing sides.
- Trim the ends of the border strips to the length of the centre unit.
- Sew on the two 21 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips to the remaining two opposing sides of the centre unit.
- Trim the ends of the border strips to the width of the centre unit.

Step 7:

- Add the two shorter strips cut in step 1 for the outer border to two opposite sides of the quilt top.
- Trim the ends of the border strips to the length of the centre unit.
- Add the two longer strips cut in step 1 to the remaining two sides of the quilt top.
- Trim the ends of the border strips to the width of the centre unit.

Step 8:

- Layer top, batting and back and quilt.
- Put on binding and label.
